Follow-up Instructions For Wart Treatment

1. Leave the moleskin patch on for at least 24 hours. Tape down if loosens.
2. Remove moleskin after 24 hours to soak.
3. Soak the foot in Epsom Salt/warm water for 15-20 minutes at a time at least twice a day until pain subsides. Use about 2-4 Tbsp (up to ¼ cup) of Epsom Salt.
4. Apply bandaid/gauze to cushion as needed.
5. Follow up within 2 weeks.
6. Expect some blistering and variable pain for 1-4 days starting usually the following day. Call the office if there are any problems, redness, streaking.

Soak as many times a day for as many days as needed until discomfort subsides
